# LaLaPicassoMusic – Student Contract

The Student will be automatically invoiced monthly (subscription billing) prior to each session. The monthly fee is based on the average number of days per month for the chosen day the student is receiving instruction. In other words, the number of classes per month will vary month to month as LaLaPicasso factors in all major holidays and will not run on those days. If you choose to cancel your lessons, a 2 week notice prior to next billing cycle is required.

The Student is responsible for his/her own attendance. If the Student cannot attend a lesson, he/she must notify the Teacher at least **24 hours** in advance in order to request a make up. Make up lessons can be arranged by contacting the teacher directly. We will provide a sub if needed.

Lessons missed due to snow days or personal conflicts will be made up at a mutually convenient time.

Students are required to own their own music and materials. If a new book is needed, we will have you purchase that book directly or we will purchase the book and you will be invoiced for the cost.

Families and teachers should have an open line of communication and an ongoing dialogue about progress, goals, scheduling. Please exchange current contact information (cell phone and email).
